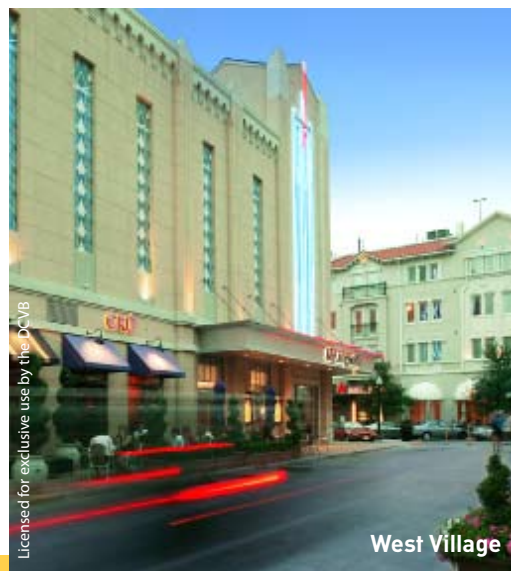
Saturday, August 29
