Article III, Section 3: Board of Directors

- The Board of Directors shall consist of nine (9) members at-large, and the VCOS IAFC Director. At-large members shall have a term of three (3) years with three (3) to be elected each year. Not more than two (2) members at-large shall be elected from any single division of the IAFC. ~~The immediate past chair will be appointed for a one-year term~~ Should the immediate past chair and/or the immediate past secretary/treasurer not be reelected or not seek reelection to the board, the board may act to appoint said past chair and/or past secretary/treasurer ~~will be appointed for a six-month term as a non-voting member~~ but may be extended until the following year's annual meeting by action of the Board of Directors upon which time the term shall terminate ~~to terminate at the following year's annual meeting.~~

- **Article V, Section 4: Eligibility for Office**

- Any member of the Section seeking election to ~~the VCOS Board of Directors any office~~ shall be a regular member of the Association and an active chief officer of a volunteer or combination Fire-Rescue or fire-based EMS agency. A combination agency consists of an active fire department with active emergency response volunteer firefighters. ~~To be eligible to run for election, the chief officer seeking election shall provide a letter of support from the fire chief, or in the case that the fire chief is seeking election, the fire chief shall provide a letter of support from their direct supervisor (mayor, city/village manager, county administrator, fire district/association/department president). Candidates without a verified letter of support will be rendered ineligible for the election.~~
