## **Report from Officers:**

- Air Force
  - AFI 32000 2001 has final signatures but have not been distributed
    - Supports base level Fire Chiefs
  - Awaiting distribution of funding, USAF is centrally funded.
- Army
  - \$127M shortfall for Army fire apparatus
  - Red River will be performing apparatus refurbishment for level II SLEP 1995 and newer. CONOS bases only
  - Obligated to follow the Scope of Service and comply
  - Risk analysis needs to be completed for each facility using the OVAP score
  - MEDCOM tasked and funded for EMS
  - Funding for fire protection is at 71%. The commander can go higher if he/she approves it.
  - CHARA holding up the hiring process. On average 6-9 months to fill a position.
  - Larger bases are browning out stations daily
  - Army F&ES does not have a wildland mission. It is a natural resources responsibility.
  - Training is linked to career progression with positive academic requirements. Minimum requirement for Assistant Fire Chief's is an Associate Degree, Deputy Chief and Fire Chief a minimum of a bachelor degree. Higher headquarter positions will require a Masters. Current positions will be grandfathered. There will be three tiers of training approach.
- o At Large (NIH, FEMA, VA)
  - Chief at NIST (Dept of Commerce) will be retiring
  - HHS will be taking a big financial hit
  - 2 ACs and Capt open awaiting approval
  - New Ambulance delivered to NIH
- Coast Guard
  - No report

  - New pumper due in middle May
  - Next year non labor money going to be cut on the Reserve side
  - New Admiral supports Fire and Emergency Services
  - Navy pushing Accreditation
